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Attire: An ASTM Approved helmet must be worn AT ALL TIMES when mounted and footwear should have a distinguishable heel while riding. Otherwise, casual attire is acceptable.

Arenas: A (20m x 40m) dressage arena will be used for all CT Dressage, USEA TOC, and Introductory Level Dressage tests. A (20m x 60m) dressage arena will be used for the Training Level through FEI Dressage, Dressage Seat Equitation and Leadline classes. A separate outdoor jumping arena will be used for combined test stadium rounds.

Non-Competing Horses: Horses **NOT** entered in classes but attending the show must have a completed entry form (for each horse) by the closing date (7/29/25). Each non- competing horse is required to wear a number when off the trailer or out of a stall.

Grounds/Haul-ins: This fee is assessed by trailer each day and does **not** have a stall reserved. Horses may **NOT** be tied to or left in trailers **overnight**.

Office Hours: The office opens at 12:00 pm on Thursday, July 31st, and at 7:00 am on Friday.

Schooling and Lungeing: Schooling may begin at 12:30 pm on Thursday, Jul. 31st. All horses are required to wear a bridle number when out of the stall whether being led, are mounted, or tied to a trailer.

Scratches from Show / Classes: Scratches on or before the closing date (Jul. 29th) will be refunded in full. No refunds after the closing date.

Class Changes: Classes can be added and changed before and during the show depending on the schedule. Requests to add or change classes before the show should be emailed to carol@scdcta.com. During the show class adds or changes should be requested in person at the show office.

Ride Times and Stall Assignments: Times and stabling assignments will be emailed to the email address on the entry form by 7/30/25. Please contact the show secretary, Carol Freligh, carol@scdcta.com or 843-857-6229 if you have questions. Stabling requests should be noted on the entry. Shavings may be purchased for \$8.00 by indicating the number on the entry.

Stabling: All stalls have been refurbished and have full rubber matting. Requests to stable with a group should be indicated on the entry form. Other specific stabling requests (for example: Stallion needs an end stall) should be indicated on the entry form.

RV Hookup: There are 50- and 30-amp RV sites. Any cord connected will be considered a hook-up per SCEP management and will be charged as an RV Hookup.
